

Introduction to Multi-Color Block Printing with Stefan Wolf

Materials List

- ‡ Paper or your sketchbook for working out ideas and taking notes.
- ‡ Drawing tools of your choice:
soft pencils, Sharpie markers, charcoal, ink and brush, Stabilo All pencils...
- ‡ A piece of non-slip rubber drawer liner mat.
This is good at keeping linoleum in place while you work.
- ‡ One or two Speedball handles with several cutters.
I typically use Nos.1 and 2 V gouges, and a No.5 U gouge. Another option is to invest in a Flexcut palm tool set.
- ‡ Two pieces of printmaking linoleum.
Mounted linoleum is easier to manage. Speedball tan and 'battleship grey' linoleum is firm. J. Richeson grey linoleum is medium soft. Moo Carve and other white or pink 'rubber' blocks are soft.
