

Next Level Art Program for High School Students with Pravina McClure

A program for high school art students with foundational art skills looking to advance their skills. Students will be mentored, coached, and encouraged to produce quality art, prepare it for marketing, and to show it professionally. The program will be led by a Neo Classical trained art instructor and will take place at the Rogue Gallery Studio.

Students will choose a theme for their work and the show. Students can express their theme through the three classic forms of expression in fine art: still life, landscape, and portrait/figurative using any of the following media: watercolor, acrylic, oil, pastel, mixed media, collage, and fiber arts. Instructor Pravina McClure will guide and direct students with their work. Students will be encouraged to communicate and share ideas with one another, and try both old and new techniques. Students have the opportunity to focus on their work, learn how to up their game, and refine their art. The Gallery will provide students with a choice of art supplies suitable for the requirements of this particular show. At the completion of the program, an exhibit of the artwork created in the program will be featured at the Rogue Gallery.
