Materials List

- ‡ Suitable for Oils, Pastel, Watercolor, Gouache, and /or Acrylic
- ‡ Three or more surfaces for your medium; such as watercolor or pastel paper, canvas, etc. Suggested sizes: 6"x8" through 11"x14"
- ‡ Primary colors; Red, Blue, Yellow, and Titanium or Zinc White
*it is a good idea to have a warm and cool version of each primary. Examples: Cad red med & Alizarin crimson, Cad yellow med & Lemon yellow, Ultramarine blue & Cerulean blue.
**Additional color options; Burnt Sienna or Paynes Grey.
- ‡ Assorted Brushes (larger sizes are better)
- ‡ Palette for paints
- ‡ Paint thinner / Odorless Mineral Spirits (Oils)
- ‡ Spray bottle (Acrylic, Gouache or Watercolor)
- ‡ Paper towels or rags
- ‡ Easel (bring a folding table if it is a table top type)
- ‡ Portable chair
- ‡ Camera
- ‡ Hat
- ‡ Bug repellent/ Sunscreen
- ‡ Bag lunch and water/ drinks to stay hydrated
